<p>Source 2 To heal & settle specifically stated (+ key phrase)</p>	<p><i>Act of Oblivion to allow Royalists to return to normality (L3 But: decimation Tax)</i></p>
<p>Source 1 To heal & settle: Reduce size of army & so reduce taxation (+ key phrase)</p>	<p><i>MG's would use a militia = saves money = less tax needed</i></p>
<p>Source 2 make the government more civilian (+ key phrase)</p>	<p><i>Attempts to make 1st & 2nd PP work (humble petition)</i></p>
<p>Source 2 & 5 godly rule mentioned (+ key phrase)</p>	<p><i>MG's (L3 But: does not support MG's with 2ndPP)</i></p>
<p>OK only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tolerance of most faiths 	<p><i>Jews, Anglicans in private, Nayler?</i></p>
