Source 3 Family resistance (+ key phrase) Fear of plot against him if Accepted (+ key phrase) Source 3 & 5 Army opposition (+ key phrases) <i>(L3 But: not concerned by This in Source 2)</i>	<i>Press attacks</i> <i>Sydenham shows this is possible</i> <i>Widespread opposition – Grandees & middle officers</i> <i>Ignores army & accepts/ dismissal of Lambert & others</i>
